## **Directions from Seattle**

I-5 to Spokane St Exit (#163), cross West Seattle Bridge, follow signs to Fauntleroy Way/Vashon Ferry. When you arrive on Vashon Island you are on the Vashon Island Highway. Travel south on this road about 9 miles to 4th flashing red light. In the little town of Burton (harbor on left, espresso stand and church on the right.) turn left at the general store, go up the hill. Follow main road to the right. In 1/2 mile see Camp Burton sign on the left and a sign for Office. Turn left into camp and park near the office

## **At Camp**

Rotary "sign in" is near Grisham Hall. After lunch you can drive to the carnival area and unload gear. Campers will give you a short camp tour and take you to Arts and Crafts to make your camp nametag.

At 11:30 in the lower level of Burton Lodge, overlooking the Sound, a panel of medical staff and campers answer questions on childhood cancer and current treatments.

Lunch at 12 or 12:30 is upstairs in Burton Lodge. Rotarians and guests sit with kids on the main level. Campers sit in cabin groups/ 8 campers, 2 Rotarians at each table.

After lunch we meet up on the porch, the kids leave for cabin "rest" hour and we get going on carnival set-up. The carnival is on the lower field near Burton Lodge. You can drive there to unload gear. We have signs for each booth or look for the field map to find your location.

Starlight gives us terrific prizes and each camper will win one. Carnival starts at 2:00 and take down starts at 4. There will be a place for you to put away the equipment belonging to the camp. Then the traditional pie in-the-face-free-for-all and water fight (which is fun and the guaranteed safety zone respected) begins.

We'll meet after on the patio of the Vashon Rock Island Pizza for drinks and pizza.
